Course content:

This is the first of three part training programme designed to equip newly and recently qualified teachers with valuable information and guidance on the National PESSYP strategy, the National Curriculum for P.E. and an introduction to Multi-Skills.

The training will consist of theoretical and practical activities helping NQT/RQT's to develop 'a *secure knowledge and understanding of their subject/curriculum areas*'.

This training will also include information on the local P.E., school sport and physical activity support network available, and a 2 hour practical session looking at the delivery of Multi-Skills as the building blocks for developing child physical literacy.

Delegates are requested to wear suitable sports clothing for the practical session.

It is intended that the following Professional Standards for Teachers will be accommodated through this training: QTS – Q14, Q15.

- To equip newly qualified teachers working in a local primary school with the knowledge and understanding to deliver safe and effective Physical Education lessons, including an awareness of the National PESSYP Strategy.
